Daniel Murray, Deputy Chief, Haz-Mat Operations, FDNY

Deputy Chief Daniel Murray will discuss his experience as a Chief in lower Manhattan and as the Chief in Charge of HazMat Operations. Over that 11-year period, Chief Murray has supervised construction and responses to modern construction including the Freedom Tower and the September 11<sup>th</sup> Memorial Museum.
